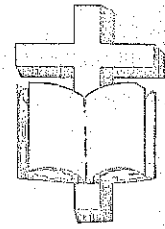

## INFORMATION ON THE SCHOOL

Trichardt School for Christian Education was founded in January 1993. The School has been a ministry of the "Igreja Reformada em Moçambique" (Reformed Church in Mozambique) since July 1993. The constitution of the school is Christian based, i.e. Christian Values and morals are the accepted norms. The aims of the school are to provide an education of high standards, to open doors for the youth of Mozambique and to help to build an honest, diligent and dedicated community, based on the principles of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

English is the medium of instruction and the School follows the South African curriculum. Students in their final year write the examinations of the (*Independent Examinations Board (IEB)*). This examination, if passed on the required level, enables the students to apply for admission at universities in South Africa and abroad.

Children from the ages of 4-6 may enrol in the Pre-school. Children must turn 7 in the year they start Grade 1.

**The School is divided into the following phases:**

**The school year consists of four terms.**

January - March; April- June; July-September; October-December

**Holidays:** as per the school calendar.

**Application Procedure:** Parents who would like to enrol their children as students at this school must make an appointment with the Headmistress and complete an enrolment form, which is obtainable from the office. The Headmistress has the right to require the applicant to complete an entry test to determine both the English and Mathematics proficiency of the student. Thereafter the placement will be confirmed.

**School Uniform:** The School uniform is *compulsory* for all the pupils, excluding pre-school children. See the information on the school uniform and regulations which are included with the enrolment form.
